The Iowa Valley Community School District calls for a special election on March 7th, 2023 to authorize general obligation bonds in an amount not to exceed \$10,615,000 for facility and learning environment improvements.

WHAT WILL BE ON THE BALLOT?

QUESTION 1 | General Obligation Bond | \$10,615,000

Shall the Board of Directors of the Iowa Valley Community School District in the County of Iowa, State of Iowa, be authorized to contract indebtedness and issue General Obligation Bonds in an amount not to exceed \$10,615,000 to provide funds to renovate, repair, remodel, improve, furnish, and equip the existing Elementary and Junior/Senior High School buildings?

QUESTION 2 | One-time Authorization

Shall the Board of Directors of the Iowa Valley Community School District in the County of Iowa, State of Iowa, be authorized to levy annually a tax exceeding Two Dollar and Seventy Cents (\$2.70) per Thousand Dollars (\$1,000), but not exceeding Four Dollars and Five Cents (\$4.05) per Thousand Dollars (\$1,000) of the assessed value of the taxable property within said school corporation to pay the principal of and interest on bonded indebtedness of said school corporation, it being understood that the approval of this proposition shall not limit the source of payment of the bonds and interest, but shall only operate to restrict the amount of bonds which may be issued?



HOW WE GOT HERE

In May of 2022, the District looked at educational, functional, and facility needs by **undertaking a comprehensive facilities assessment** of our buildings and grounds.

In the Fall of 2022, the **lowa Valley CSD** School Board, along with the District's administration and a community facilities committee, reviewed priority items, potential solutions/projects, and estimated costs while recognizing the importance of fiscal responsibility, updating the aging facilities, and creating an efficient and complete scope of work.

- Create safe and secure entry
- Improve ventilation and HVAC systems
- Upgrade outdated electrical systems
- Replace fire alarm system
- Remove asbestos throughout buildings
- Replace roofing

Learning Environments

- Update Career and Technical Education (CTE) ag and shop space
- Update classroom fixtures and furnishings
- Upgrade to LED lighting and replace ceiling tiles


